A KISS OF <u>AFFECTION</u> - HONESTY = <u>INTIMACY</u>

A KISS OF ALLEGIANCE - HONESTY = LOYALTY

#### **NOTHING BUT THE TRUTH**

3 Steps to Living in Truth

- SPEAK TO REFLECT <u>REALITY</u>, NOT ELEVATE <u>POSITION</u>. (Psalm 36:2-3, Matthew 26:33-35)
- SEEK TRUTH EVEN IF IT <u>HURTS</u> THAT YOU MAY <u>GROW</u> FROM IT. (Proverbs 15:31-32, Psalm 119:27-29 NLT)
- SEE <u>HONESTY</u> AS A MEANS TO <u>HONOR</u> GOD, OTHERS AND YOURSELF. (Proverbs 12:22 NLT, John 8:42-47)
