

THE INTERMEDIATE HEAVEN


Moments after a believer dies...

- We have <u>IMMEDIATE</u> access to <u>GOD</u>. (Luke 16:22, Luke 23:42-43, Philippians 1:23-24, 2 Corinthians 5:6-10)
- We are <u>SIMILAR</u> but <u>DIFFERENT</u>. (Luke 16:19-31)
- We are <u>AWARE</u> of some <u>EVENTS</u> on earth. (Hebrews 12:1-3, Luke 15:7&10, Revelation 6:9-11)
- We go before the <u>KING</u> and <u>WORSHIP</u>. (Revelation 4:1-2,10,5:9-14)
- We <u>AWAIT</u> a <u>FAMILY</u> reunion. (1 Thessalonians 4:13-18)


