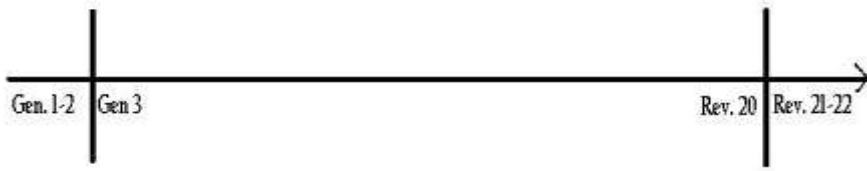

(1 Thessalonians 4:13-18)

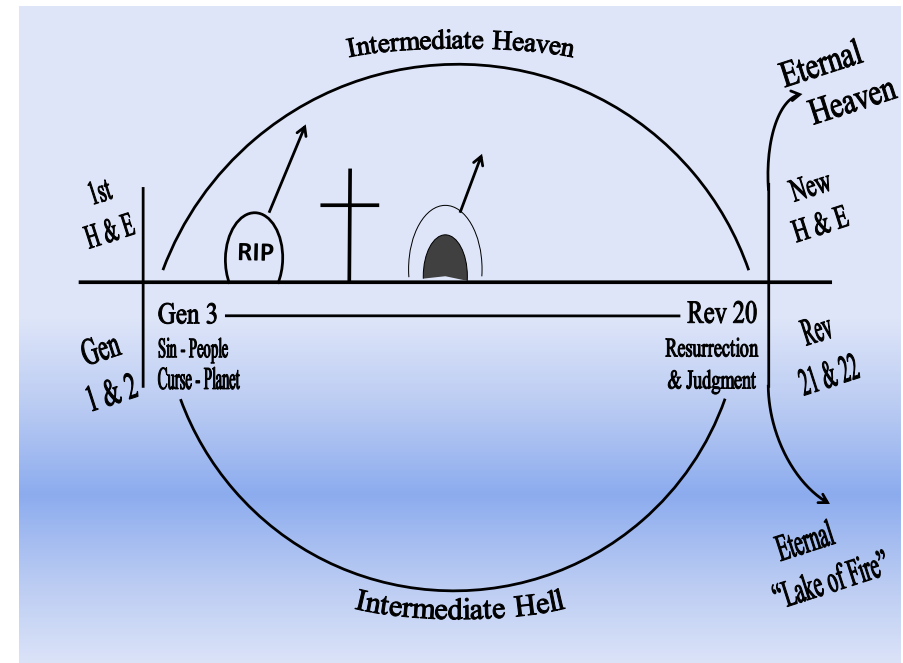

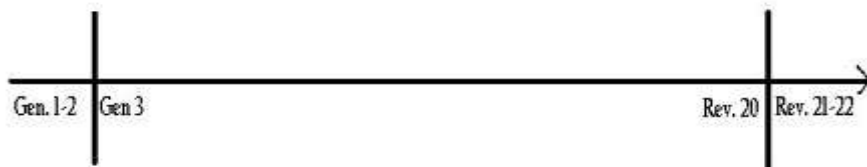
