- BECAUSE GOD IS <u>IN CONTROL</u>

- WAIT EXPECTANTLY

WHEN PEOPLE ARE <u>UNCHANGEABLE</u> (James 5:9-11a)

- BECAUSE GOD <u>REWARDS PATIENCE</u>

- WAIT <u>QUIETLY</u>

WHEN PROBLEMS ARE <u>UNEXPLAINABLE</u> (James 5:11-12)

- BECAUSE GOD IS <u>WORKING THINGS OUT</u>

- WAIT <u>CONFIDENTLY</u>
