- **2** <u>ACT</u> on the faith you have. (Mark 9:22b-24, James 2:26, Mark 5:25-34)
- **SEMEMBER** <u>PRAYER</u> is ours <u>RESULTS</u> are God's. (Mark 9:22b-24, Daniel 3:17-18)
