- ❷ People need ANSWERS, not ARGUMENTS.
(1 Peter 3:15-16, 2 Timothy 2:14-16, Col 4:2-6, Phil 2:14-16)
- ❸ Not everyone will RECEIVE your WORDS.
(Mark 10:17-27, Acts 13:49-52, Acts 14:1-7)
- ❹ On average it takes SIX people to MAKE A DIFFERENCE.

- ❺ Remember SALVATION is God's, not YOURS.
